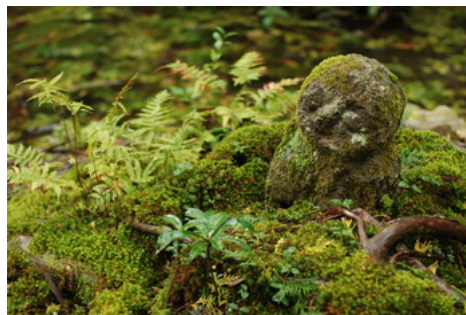
Report: Welcome Event for New International Students "Kyoto Walking Tour ~ Ohara~" (presented by SIED)
