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Report: "Online Lunch Talk" (presented by SIED)

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"Lunch Talk" is a popular project of Imadegawa SIED, which students talk to each other while eating lunch. However, due to the influence of the coronavirus, it is difficult to have a face-to-face meal with conversation, so we held an "Online Lunch Talk" using a video conferencing app. This time, the language used for conversation was set to Japanese, and local students and international students interacted in Japanese.
