

For non-Japanese customers who do not have an ordinary savings account

The Japan Post Bank offers a service that allows non-Japanese customers who are opening a Japan Post Bank account for the first time to easily fill out the application form using a PC at home.

Using this service, customers can prepare and print various application documents simply by entering the customer information necessary to open an account (name, address, date of birth, etc.) on the webpage. With the printed application form and other documents, you can apply to open an account.

This service is available in multiple languages, and you can enter information and check explanations in languages other than Japanese for your convenience.

① Go to Japan Post Bank's website and click on "総合口座開設" ("Opening an ordinary savings account").



② Scroll down.


③ Click on "インターネットで申込書を作成する" ("Fill out the application form online") to go to the page to complete the form.

Steps for applying to open an account with this service

① Select an account type

Access the page to fill out the application form, choose your language, and then select your account type.

What is "ゆうちょダイレクト+(プラス)" ("Yucho Direct Plus")?

- ✓ No need to manage a passbook, as this is a passbook-less ordinary savings account
- ✓ No need to visit a bank or an ATM for passbook updates or renewals
- ✓ Deposit and withdrawal transactions can be viewed online up to for 15 months.
(Up to two months with regular Yucho Direct)

What is "総合口座" ("ordinary savings account")?

- ✓ A passbook is issued for this account type.


② Input customer information

Enter information necessary to open an account.

Note 1: Please enter your name and other details exactly as shown on your residence card.

Note 2: When a non-Japanese customer opens an account by filling out an application form on this website, the name of the account holder will be registered in alphabetical letters.

③ Print the application form and complete the procedure

Print the application form and follow the appropriate procedure below according to the account type you selected.

Please note that entering the information and printing the form with this service alone is not sufficient to

complete the account opening procedure.

Please sign the application form, affix the printed address slip to the envelope, and insert the application form, a copy of your identification card (residence card), a copy of your passport, and other necessary documents in the envelope, then put it in a post box.

Ordinary savings account

Please stamp the application form with your personal seal and affix your signature, and bring it in person, together with identification documents (residence card) and your registered seal, to a post office savings counter or a Japan Post Bank branch to complete the account opening procedure.
